Keynote title: *“Pedagogy of Connection: Arts-Based and Participatory Simulation for Interprofessional Learning”*

Marco worked as an internal medicine specialist and clinical teacher in internal medicine wards, intensive care units and emergency departments in Brazil for 20 years. He then transitioned to researching, developing and implementing evidence-based educational practices. He is passionate about medical education in general, and active methodologies in particular. His research focuses on digital education, clinical reasoning, the development of professional identity, and the use of the arts in health professions education.
